

From the Principals Desk

Kia ora Koutou

Term 2 has arrived and it is always great to welcome our students back to school and see them reconnecting with their friends.

Due to roll growth, we are opening a new classroom in the library as of Monday 6th May. We extend a warm welcome to Cushla McKerchar and Glenda Begg, who will be team teaching and bringing a wealth of expertise to Waihao Downs School.

This week the student numbers in Kākano are 28 and Pihinga have 26. These two classes have been rearranged into the following: Kākano 17, Pihinga 19 and Māhuri 18. Parents and whānau of students who are moving classes were sent a letter home on Monday. If you have any queries or concerns, please contact your child's current teacher or myself. Teachers will work with students this week to ensure a smooth transition into their new classes.

My last day as principal at Waihao Downs will be on the 7th June. The decision to leave my principal role is bittersweet but the time is right and I need to reduce my work load. An acting principal will be appointed for the last 4 weeks of the school term.

Classrooms

Our classroom names reflect the growth of our school symbol the Oak Tree. Kākano – seed, Pihinga - the sprout, Māhuri - young tree or sapling, Rākau- tree. The old administration block will be used as break out spaces for small groups, our itinerant teachers for music, speech and drama. The Mobile Kindy will also occupy the space on a Thursday morning. We have named the area Tipu which means "to grow."

A reminder that students can bring food to be heated on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays. Food is to be wrapped in tinfoil and named or in an oven proof container.


